HEADLIGHTS ON...Coach Zingg!!

Howard Zingg, bus driver, is a specialist and trains young folks in throwing the discus and the shot put.



His coaching career began in early spring of 1995 when he was introduced to a high school female student who asked for help in throwing the discus. In less than a year she increased her throwing distance from 105 feet to 144 feet, 10 inches. Through that student, he was introduced to another student and his training with the latter student in both the discus and shot put enabled her to eventually throwing the shot 48 feet, 5 inches, which still stands as a city record, while also breaking the city record (at that time) by tossing the discus 151 feet, 8 inches. He has helped another student to train starting in the eighth grade and continuing through her senior year in high school. In 2005, Christina Mueller established the current city record in the discus with a throw of 160 feet, 10 inches, which placed her 5th in the state all-time. These young ladies were able to obtain college scholarships attending Texas State University, Texas A & M and Southern Methodist University respectively.

He is currently working with several students from around the area and it's no wonder he's a super driver. Howard started his training business after beginning to throw the discus and shot put in November of 1994. Since then, and after starting his business, he's advanced personally in the sports after qualifying in the Florida State Senior Games competition and moving on to the National level where he's placed third in the discus, bringing a Bronze Medal home. Since that time, Mr. Zingg has achieved more in local and state meets winning several Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. We're proud to have you on the team Coach, and "CONGRATS".

District Receives a State Grant to Upgrade School Buses

This initiative, with the lead of our Fleet Foreman, Earl Stewart, resulted in the recognition and receipt of a grant totaling \$208,898.72 from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Clean School Bus Program.

The grant will go toward retrofitting 136 NEISD school buses with technology to improve emission air quality. Says Stewart, "We applied for this grant this past August to be proactive for improving the emissions of our older buses (year models 2000—2006) without using M&O (local) funds." Purchase of 130 new buses from the 2007 Bond Package to be completed in school year 2009-2010, along with this initiative, will result in 266 (71%) buses of the fleet providing added emission reduction to further enhance the health

and safety of our students and better contribute support to the community's ecological programs.

Texas Commissioner Larry R. Soward recently remarked, "A relatively small investment in a retrofit can reduce emissions by 70-80 percent" and "By installing these devices, we can protect the health of Texas school children."

The retrofit will include a Closed Crankcase Filtration System, which reduces particulate matter emissions by 80 percent, and Diesel Oxidation Catalysts, which further eliminates emissions by 20 to 40 percent. These model buses were chosen so they could be retained and used for at least the next five years after date of the retrofit.

The installation of the devices on the selected buses is scheduled through March, 2009.

Transportation at Health and Wellness Fair

Recently, the Transportation Department participated in the District's Health and Wellness Fair at Blossom Athletic Center. The picture below shows one of our DT466 clean burning diesel engines with an Eco fuel enhancer. The Eco fuel enhancer has been added to our bus fleet to help reduce exhaust emissions and improve the fuel economy. We would like to thank Mr. Ben Talamantez from ECO System and Mr. Richard Tuttle from Longhorn Bus Sales for supporting the event.
